



ON-LEASH POLICY

Woofers World does not endorse dog minders exercising dogs off leash when participating in a Sleepover.

As pet owners and dog trainers, we're advocates for safe off-leash play however in the Sleepover situation it's in everyone's best interest that the dog remain safe and avoid the risks that are associated with off-leash play.

Exercising a Sleepover dog away from the minder's home without tethering by a leash or cord contravenes the Victorian Code of Practices for Boarding and is at odds with Woofers World Sleepover safe practices.

If you instruct your dog minder to exercise your dog 'off-leash', you acknowledge that it is against our policy and a breach of your agreed Terms and Conditions.

As the pet's owner you may have a good understanding of your dog's behaviour and you can reasonably predict that your dog will be safe while being exercised off-leash by an unfamiliar person.

Use this form if you accept the added risk of off-leash play and if you wish to instruct your dog minder to exercise your dog off-leash in public dog off-leash areas.
