SLEEPOVER CHECKLIST

Preparing your pooch for their Sleepover



1. Visit the minder's home

A preliminary visit will help your dog become familiar with the scents and sounds of the minder's home. Allow your dog to spend some time at the house before the Sleepover begins.

2. Give your dog a bath

Please make sure that your dog arrives freshly washed or groomed.

3. De flea & worm

Ensure your dog is treated for fleas and worms before their holiday begins, or provide the treatment for the minder to administer during their care.

4. Confirm with the minder

SMS or phone the minder and re-confirm what time your dog will be arriving at their holiday destination.

Packing Checklist

Pet Care instructions

Print off and fill in the Pet Care Instructions form for the minder to have handy on their fridge. It outlines feeding, exercise, medications, contact details etc.

Food

Provide a measuring cup for specific quantities as well as an easy to store container or individual snap lock bags specifying the days of the week.

Bowls

Having a familiar food & water bowl will help your pooch settle into the minder's home. Please make sure these are clean.

Bedding

Make sure bed covers are freshly washed.

Toys

Provide toys or anything that is familiar or smells like you. Chewing releases a hormone in dogs that helps soothes them, so make sure to include a chew toy or treat/bone.

Off-Leash Consent Form

Only if your dog has **exceptional** recall whilst off-leash, please print off and fill in the *Off-Leash Waiver* to provide written consent for your dog to be exercised without a leash in a suitable off-leash area.
